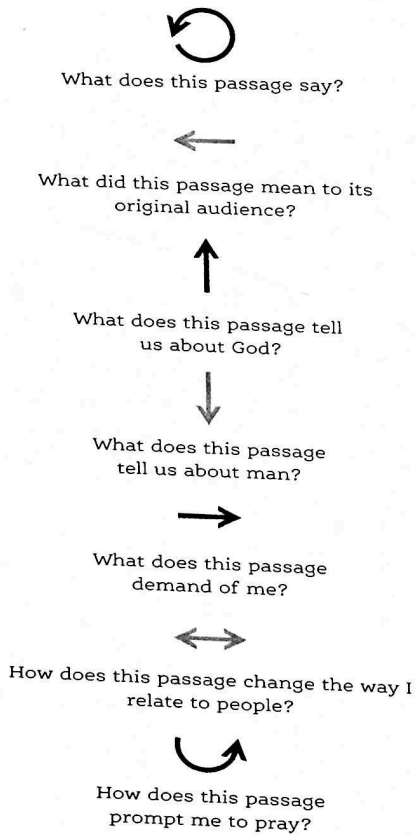


# DAILY DEVOTIONS

## 2 TIMOTHY 3:10-14

The apostle Paul had shown Timothy what it looks like to truly live for Jesus. Now it was up to Timothy to continue in what you have learned (3:14). **PSALM 119:1-4**

Everyone wants to know the key to happiness. The psalmist gives us the answer to the blessed life in Psalm 119. He says the blessed and happy life is one that walks according to God's Word, seeks the Lord, and is careful to obey Him. Don't let the devil deceive you into thinking that great happiness is to be found in sin, or self, or social status. The blessed life is found in Jesus. If you will keep His Word diligently, you will know what true blessing is.

# PSALM 119:5-8

God's Word can act like a mirror for our souls. It causes us to look face-to-face with our sin and failure. When we aren't obeying God, the knowledge of His commands brings shame. But you don't have to live in shame. Jesus can make you clean. When you walk into obedience, you will have a clear conscience. God will never abandon His children, so you can trust and follow Him every day. Whatever is keeping you from obeying God's Word, it's not worth it. Put it behind you and follow God!

# PSALM 119:9-16

To treasure something means to store it in a secure place. The psalmist kept his way pure by storing God's Word in his heart. The goal isn't just to know it, but to live according to it. When we seek the Lord (see 1:10), we will be able to walk in purity. We will be as empty as a water hose disconnected from the water spicket if we try to live apart from God's Word. But when we are filled with God's Word, we will find the wisdom to live in God's Word.
